

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE NOTICE

Weeks of: February 1, 2016 and February 15, 2016

What to Expect On-Site:

During the next two weeks, the General Contractor, Foulger-Pratt, will continue with receipt of material deliveries requiring heavy equipment accessing the site.

Installation of concrete structure, waterproofing, sleeves, walls, columns and elevated decks continues. Drainage piping, electric conduits and HVAC ducts are being installed. The first of the three towers is now reaching its full height and neighbors can have a better idea of the eventual height of the three towers on the building platform. By early March, we hope to have the concrete frame for all three towers in place.

The exterior façade metal framing has started. This framing will support the subsequent sheathing, masonry, metal panels and window systems. Sheathing for the elevator shaft walls has begun.

Installation of underground electrical duct banks and vaults inside the perimeter fence along South Dakota Avenue has started and will continue for several months to allow Pepco to provide permanent power to the site and to allow electrical service, currently running overhead along South Dakota, to be installed underground.

The area of work for Building A is primarily bounded by South Dakota Avenue on the east, the Aventine buildings on the west, Galloway Street on the south, and what will be the new alignment for Ingraham Street on the north.

Lane Closures:

The lane closures to perform new utility installations in South Dakota Avenue and Galloway Street will continue intermittently. This will require up to two lanes to be closed occasionally from the hours of 9 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Construction Hours:

Initial construction activity will be taking place Monday – Saturday between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m.
