Unfortunately, D.C. did not have a program that could help her. The M.O.W.S. Act fills that gap.

The M.O.W.S. Act Helps Seniors With Yard Work So They Can Age in Place

The legislation would create a program that provides landscaping services to our seasoned residents, including:

- ✓Lawn fertilization, aeration, seeding, and mowing
- ✓Yard cleanup, including weed control and leaf removal
- ✓Gutter cleaning
- ✓Snow removal

M.O.W.S. Program to be housed within the Office on Aging

- ✓Bill would establish a fund within the Office of Aging
- ✓Office of Aging would be tasked with designing the program and finding a contractor to complete the work
- ✓Landscaping and other work would be completed by professionals

Legislation provides a simple solution to a common problem

- ✓Seniors can sometimes find one-time volunteer help, but not recurring assistance
- ✓Many seniors keep the interior of their home in immaculate condition, but cannot keep up with the demands of outdoor work
