









As with all construction projects, construction-related noise and disruption will be part of the process as the team builds your new library.



CONSTRUCTION DETAILS

- Permitted hours of 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM Monday through Saturday
- Actual work hours and days shorter
- All work will take place within the enclosed construction fence
- The construction equipment entails during demolition an excavator with a claw that is gradually dismantling the building and debris will be hauled off via trucks
- The library walkway on South Dakota Ave. closest to the building will remain inaccessible to enable demolition
- The sidewalk on South Dakota, Jefferson St & Kennedy St. will continue to remain open for the foreseeable future
- During the rebuild of the library, short term sidewalk closures will be permitted through DDOT and this information will be shared in advance from the library both with the ANC & the community at large
- Trucks will enter and exit the site via South Dakota Avenue into the construction enclosure from Kennedy Street
- Consigli Construction is taking all necessary measures to run a safe operation, and as with all construction projects,
 construction-related noise will be part of the process as the team builds your new library.


