

DPR OVERVIEW




DPR is the # 1 ranked park system in the country.

Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) hosts programming and events year-round in 244 sites and across 900 acres of green space in all 8 Wards.

DPR annually has upwards of over 100+ different capital improvement projects in our construction pipeline to support the District's park system .

Reduced Rate Info

- DPR offers a reduced rate for summer camps to DC residents who qualify. Visit dprsummercamp.com to find the online application.
- After completing the form, applicants will be contacted by DPR to schedule an appointment to provide the required proof of residency and income.
- Qualifying families will receive either a 50% or 75% discount, depending on income level.
- The application is only for a reduced rate and does NOT secure a spot in camp.
- To receive a reduced rate, residents MUST be approved for the reduced rate BEFORE registering for camp.
