
JOSEPHITE SEMINARY SITE

- Historic Preservation. Prior to the issuance of the first building permit for the Project, the Applicant shall submit a historic landmark application, seeking historic designation of the Seminary Building and associated grounds, with the District of Columbia Historic Preservation Office.
 - Historic Landmark application submitted February 2021
 - Historic Preservation Office Public Meeting on Application set for April 28, 2022
 - Building and grounds around are subject to Historic Application (Approx 4 acres)
 - What Approval of Historic Status Means
- 196. Historic Preservation of Private Structures and Parks. The Project's historic preservation measures with respect to the Seminary and associated grounds are also superior public benefits. (*Id.* § 305.5(e).) As noted above, portions of the Property, including the Seminary itself, are to be designated a historic landmark and preserved indefinitely from future redevelopment.
