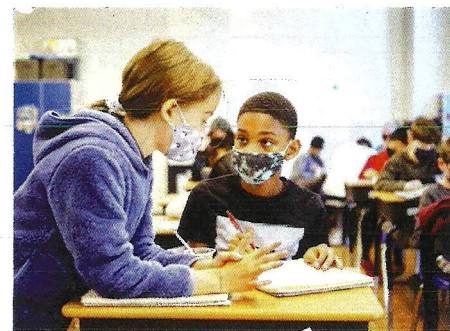
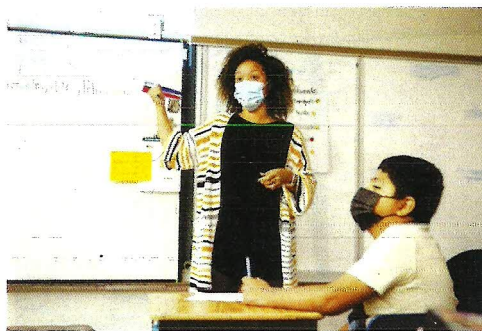


MISSION:

Currently, DC Bilingual serves more than 500 students from PK3 to 5th grade from across the District, a majority of which reside in Wards 4 and 5. As ranked by the DC Public Charter School Board, DC Bilingual is a Tier 1, high-performing school. Additionally, our school stands out from other language immersion public charter schools due to our ability to provide resources, learning opportunities, and direct services to members of the surrounding neighborhood by leveraging an extensive network of partners.

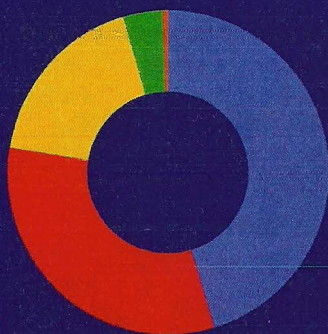

ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- » From data collected in 2021-2022 school year:
 - On average, DC Bilingual students in grades 3-5 outscored students from the same age group on PARCC standardized tests for math & literacy
 - For those classified as special education or English-language learners, DC Bilingual students ranked among the top performing public charter schools in DC.
- » Named a U.S. Department of Education National Green Ribbon School (2021).

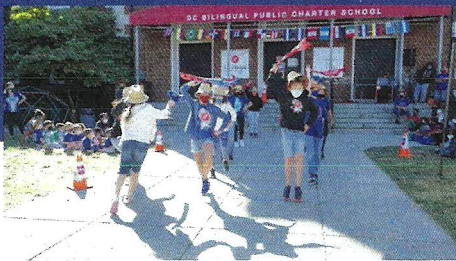
