

Notice of Request to Amend Charter Facility – **Social Justice PCS**Open for Public Comment

Public Comment Accepted Until May 20, 2024

SUMMARY: The District of Columbia Public Charter School Board (DC PCSB) announces an opportunity for the public to comment on a request from Social Justice Public Charter School (PCS) to amend its charter by relocating its facility. The school proposes moving from its current shared space with Rocketship PCS – Infinity Community Prep at 5450 Third Street NE (Ward 5) to a new facility 0.1 miles away at 333 Kennedy Street NE (Ward 5). The change would be effective for school year (SY) 2024 – 25. The school submitted its request on April 3, 2024.¹

Founded in SY 2020 – 21, Social Justice PCS enrolls 115 students in grades 5 through 8. Its mission is "Social Justice [PCS] will catalyze an integrated community of middle school students, 5^{th} – 8^{th} grade, to be scholar-activists who are designers of a more just world."
