From Council Member Lewis-George's Office (Ward 4) Applying for a Sidewalk Shoveling Exemption

DC's Department of Public Works maintains a Sidewalk Shoveling Exemption Program which exempts disabled and senior residents from removing snow and ice from their sidewalks within the first eight hours of daylight after the end of a storm. Applying for Home Energy Assistance

DC's Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) opens to new applications on October 1st. LIHEAP assists income-eligible District households with heating and cooling energy costs. Families may receive energy bill assistance between \$250 and \$1,800 as a one-time regular energy assistance benefit. Residents can schedule appointments to apply for benefits on DOEE's website.
