



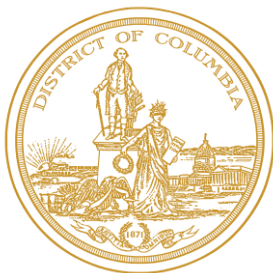
# Thank You Lamond-Riggs Citizens Association


