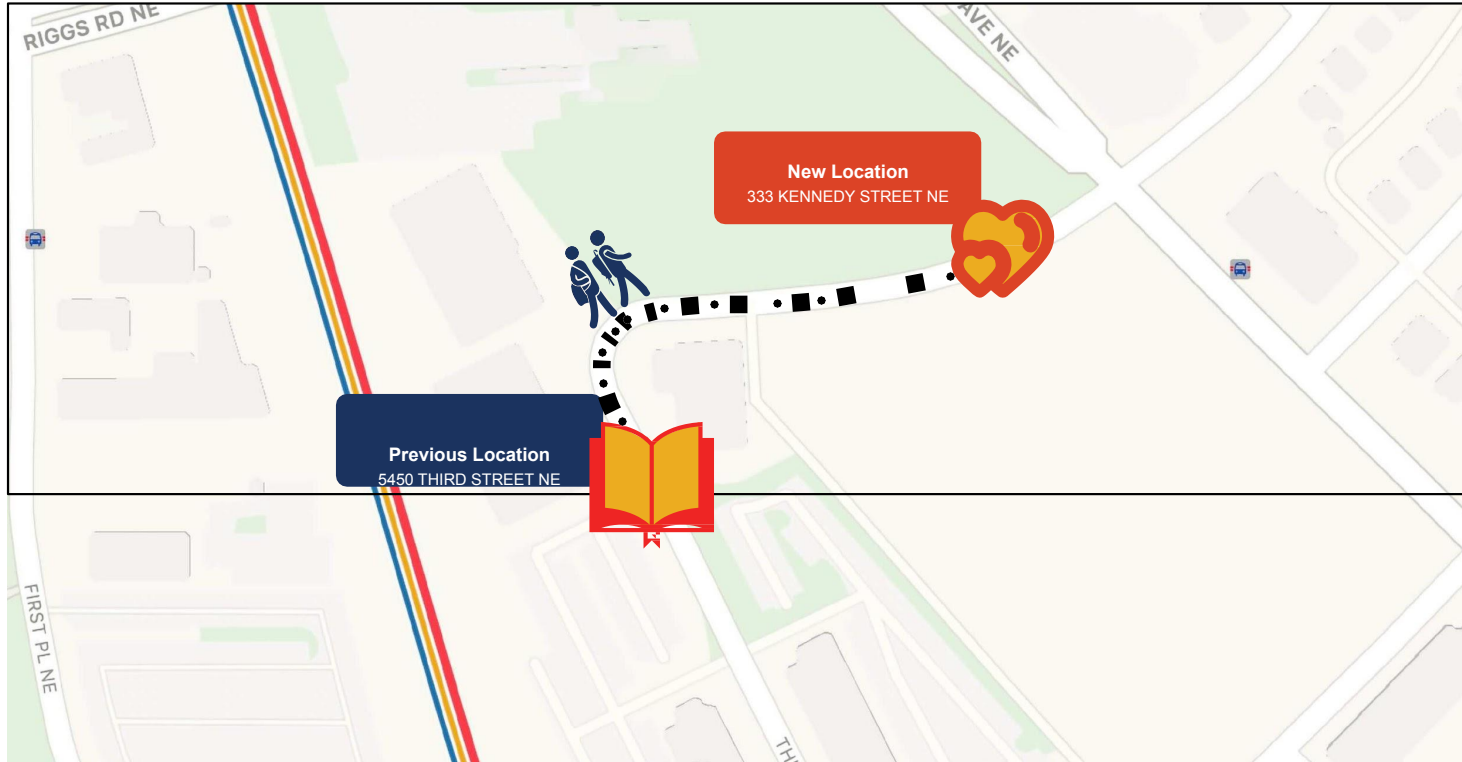

LONG-TERM EXPANSION

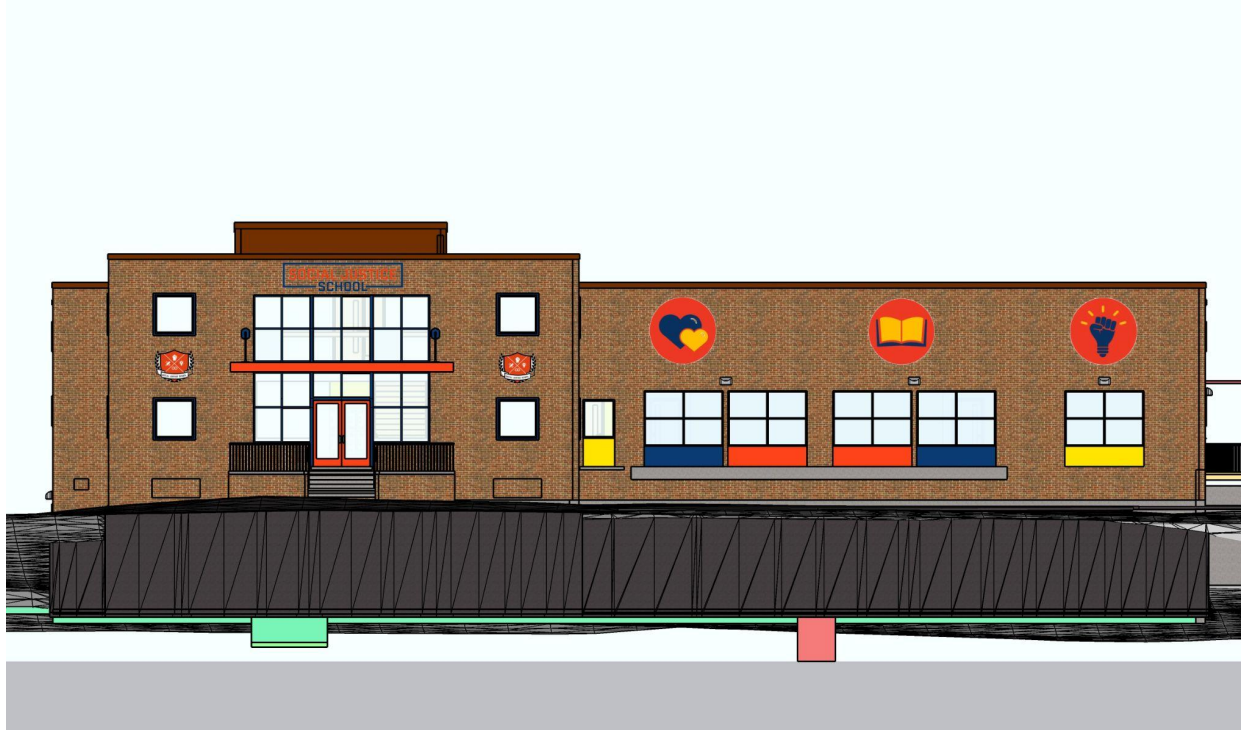
Adjacent to a potential long-term home & 5455 Third, allowing growth to up to 300 students.



COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

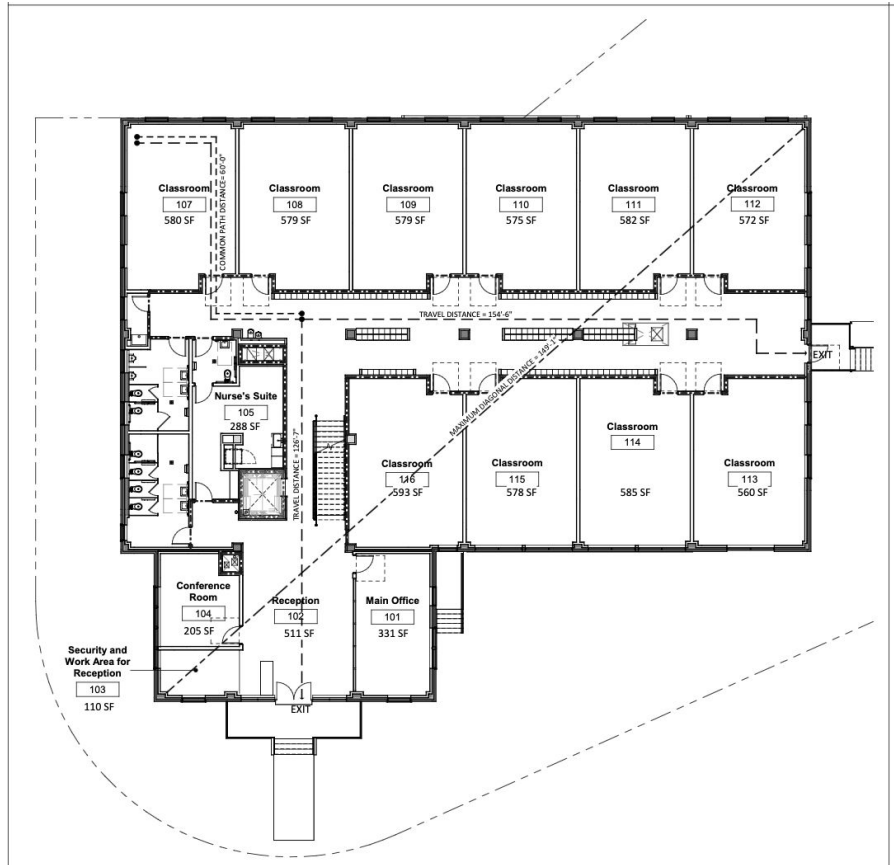

5455 Third Street: Exterior Design



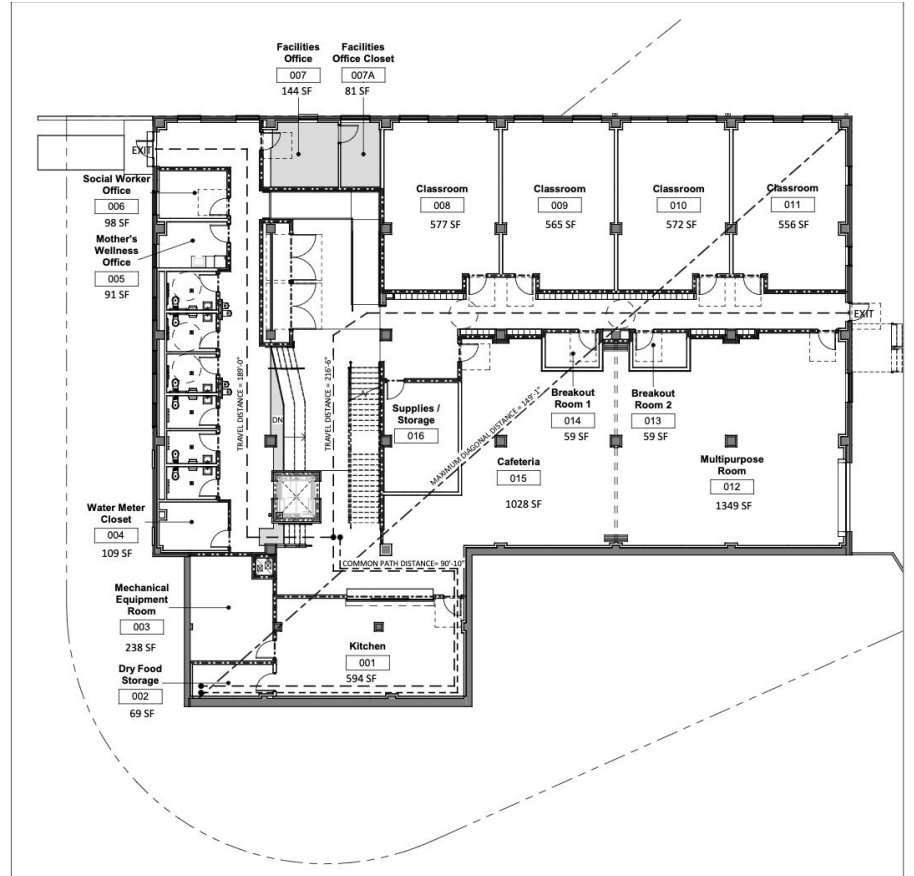


First Floor

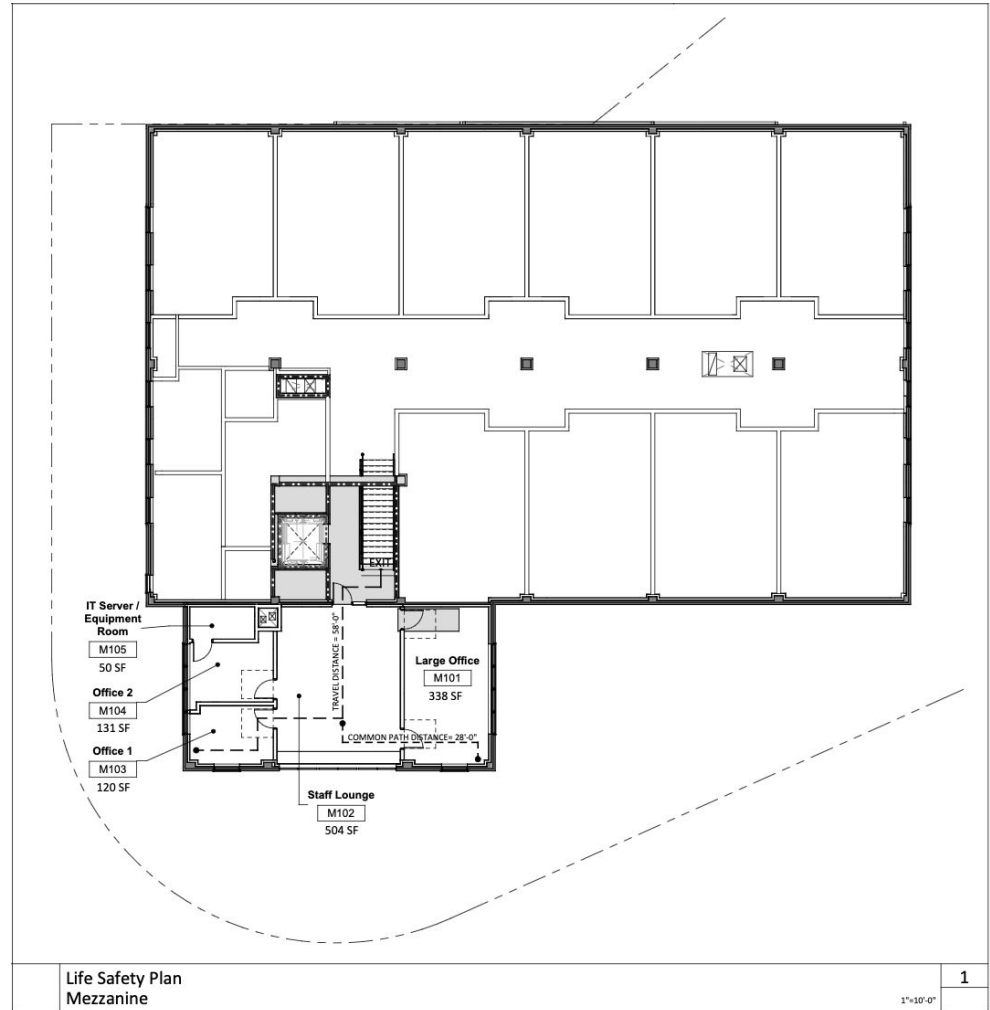




Ground Floor
