Re: Daylighting and parking adjustment at 6th and Madison St NE

Dear Chairperson Christian,

Pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000” D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent (NOI) to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction:

- **Parking modification at the intersection of 6th and Madison St NE**

DDOT is proposing to daylight the intersection of 6th and Madison St NE to proactively enhance safety near schools. By installing pavement markings and flexposts within 25 feet of the existing crosswalk, we aim to improve visibility for both drivers and pedestrians and to prevent illegal parking near the crosswalks.

Although parking within an intersection is already prohibited under [DCMR Title 18, Section 2405](#), DDOT has observed that inaccurate parking signs are currently installed in this area. These signs may cause confusion and could lead to unintentional parking violations. To resolve this issue, DDOT is proposing to remove the incorrect parking sign and install appropriate pavement markings and flexposts. Because of existing fire hydrant at this location, the ‘No Parking’ zone will be extended to 60 feet to comply with safety requirements.

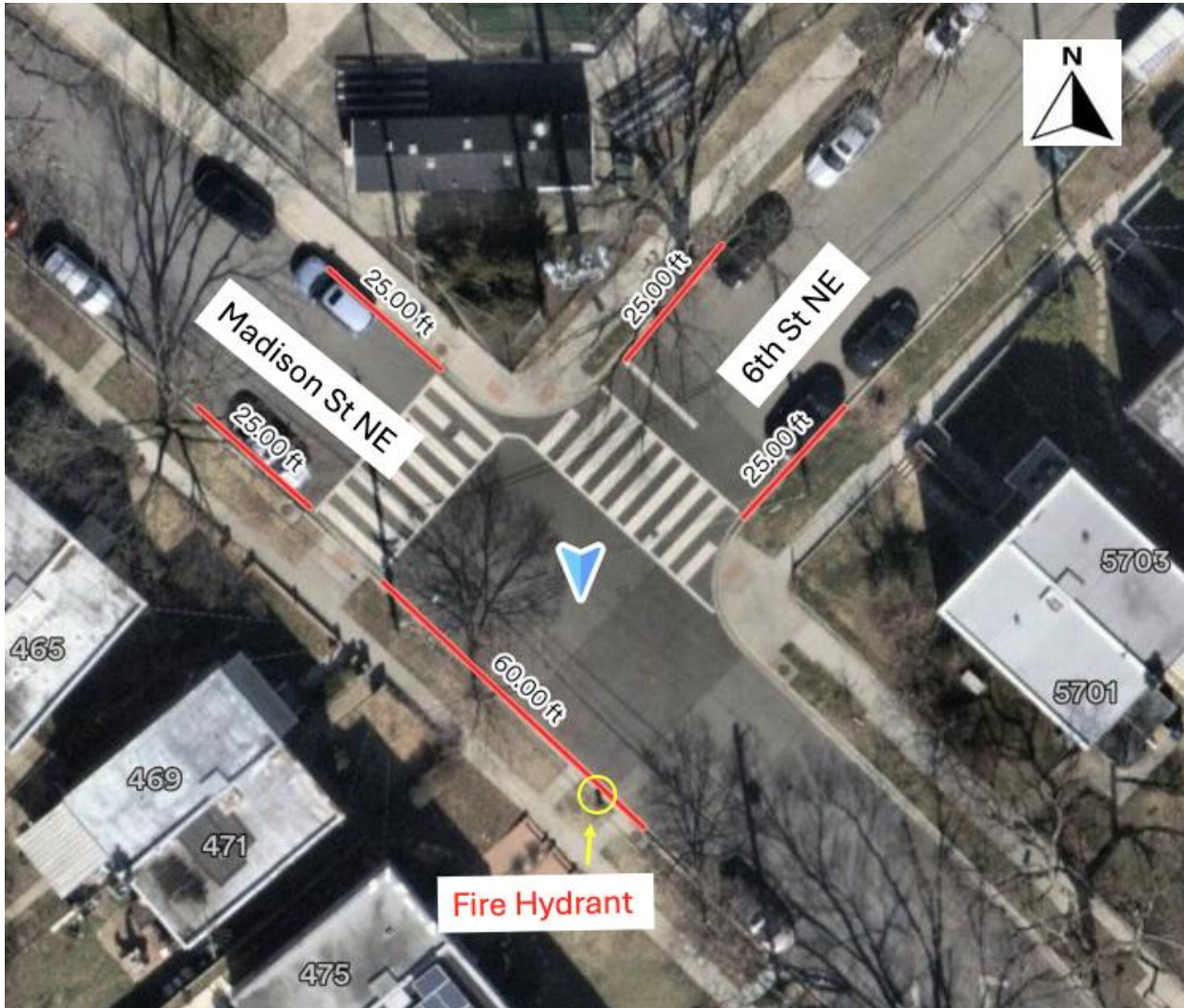


Figure 1: Proposed changes at the intersection of 6th and Madison NE. Each red line indicates length of each daylighting zone. White pavement markings and flexposts will be installed.

Figure 1 provides a visual layout of these improvements.

What is “daylighting?”

"Daylighting" improves safety by removing parked cars near crosswalks and intersections, ensuring drivers and pedestrians can see each other clearly. DDOT implements daylighting through pavement markings and flexposts. Please refer to the example photo on the right.
